NAB ATV/UTV Safety Requirement (1 of 2):

Effective Immediately – all ATV/UTV maximum speed shall be <u>operator limited to</u>:

- Above Ground -- Limited to 20 mph in the U.S. and 35 km/h in Canada 35
- Below Ground -- No change as per Site specified max speed

Future NAB guidance –

- > Plan is to require all ATV/UTV vehicles to be governed at maximum speed
- Above Ground governed limit of 20 mph in the U.S. and 35 km/h in Canada
- Below Ground No changes to speed limit. Governed limit of 20 mph in the U.S. and 35 km/h in Canada.
- Procurement requirement details will be included





NAB Aerial Lift Safety Requirement (2 of 2):

- Begin Implementation Immediately all workers travelling in an aerial lift shall be restrained with a 4 Foot / 1.2 Meter <u>fixed length Safety Restraint</u> to prevent ejection from the basket in case of incident
 - > The fixed length of 4 ft / 1.2-meter is only needed when the aerial lift is travelling from place to place
 - For more mobility in the basket, occupants may switch from the 4 ft / 1.2-meter Safety Restraint to other approved lanyard once the aerial lift is parked at the work location.
 - > 4 ft / 1.2-meter Safety Restraints are in stock and available for use
