

DOT Medical Certification Requirements

- 1. It is the Driver's responsibility to schedule their DOT Physicals with the Onsite Clinic
- 2. Physicals must be done every 1 2 years based on expiration date of your card
- 3. Physicals should be scheduled approx. 30 days before Medical Certification Card expires
- 4. Temporary Medical Cards or Extensions will no longer be provided
- 5. Driver is required to bring all clearance letters from primary / treating physician at the time of scheduled DOT Physical. A new medical clearance letter is required each year for any of the conditions below

Example of Medical Conditions that require a Medical Clearance.

- Illness or injury within the last 5 years
- Head/Brain injuries, disorders or illnesses
- · Seizures, epilepsy
- Eye disorders or impaired vision (except corrective lenses)
- Ear disorders, loss of hearing or balance
- Heart disease or heart attack; other cardiovascular condition
- Heart surgery (valve replacement/bypass, angioplasty, and pacemaker)
- High blood pressure
- Muscular disease
- Shortness of breath
- · Lung disease, emphysema, asthma, chronic bronchitis
- Kidney disease, dialysis
- Liver disease
- Digestive problems
- · Diabetes or elevated blood sugar controlled by diet, pills or insulin
- Nervous or psychiatric disorders e.g. severe depression, anxiety
- · Loss of, or altered consciousness
- Fainting, dizziness
- Sleep disorders, pauses in breathing while asleep, daytime sleepiness, loud snoring
- Stroke or paralysis
- · Missing or impaired hand, arm, foot, leg, finger, toe
- Spinal injury or disease
- Chronic low back pain
- · Regular, frequent alcohol use
- Narcotic or habit forming drug use (including prescriptions)
- 6. Medical Cards must be filed with the state no later than 5 calendar days from date of exam. This can be done online.
- 7. No reimbursement for filing Medical Certification late.
- 8. Failure to file your Medical Certification in a timely manner will disqualify your CDL and you will be suspended from the CMV Program until your CDL has been reinstated.
