#### EHSS North America Program – Electrical Safety All Personnel, Appendix B

The following table outlines the responsibilities for specific groups / roles as required for *EHSS North America Electrical Safety All Personnel* program:

Group / Role	Responsibilities
General Manager	<ul> <li>Provides required resources for the training and retraining of Qualified and Non-qualified personnel</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ensures required PPE and Electrical Safety Equipment is available to Mosaic employees</li> </ul>
Health and Safety Managers	<ul> <li>Utilizes the PMO Process for updating and maintaining this Program</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ensures the Mosaic Incident Investigation Program is followed when electrical incidents occur</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Audits and maintains documentation of audits of Electrical Safety Program and Electrical Safety Training</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Measure and Evaluate the effectiveness of this program</li> </ul>
Engineering - Electrical Safety Program	<ul> <li>Supports the PMO process for maintaining and updating this Program</li> </ul>
Administrator.	<ul> <li>Monitors the effectiveness of this program</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ensures that the Incident Energy Analysis for each facility is properly updated and maintained</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Provides assistance as needed for approving the selection and use of Electrical Safety equipment and clothing</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Coordinates with Mosaic Training to ensure training is provided to Mosaic employees exposed to electrical hazards</li> </ul>
Electrical Supervision	<ul> <li>Ensures that this Program is followed by all employees and contractors</li> </ul>
	Addresses electrical hazards identified by all personnel
	<ul> <li>Reports observed violations of this Program to the appropriate party</li> </ul>
	Determines if an individual meets the requirements to be considered a Qualified Person for a specific task

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Стопру поло	Ensures the MOC process is followed for changes to electrical equipment and those changes are properly documented and equipment labels updated as required
	<ul> <li>Supports the development of and implements site-specific</li> <li>Safe Electrical Work Policies and Procedures</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Approves the selection and use of PPE and Electrical Safety equipment</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Is knowledgeable on applicable Electrical Safety regulations, codes and requirements</li> </ul>
Qualified Person	
	<ul> <li>Complies with the safety-related work practices and procedures within this Program and the Electrical Safety Qualified Program</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Is knowledgeable in the construction and operation of equipment or specific work method</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Performs only tasks that they are competent, trained, and qualified to perform</li> </ul>
	Stops any work deemed unsafe
	<ul> <li>Takes appropriate action including communication to the appropriate management level when new or previously unknown hazards are identified</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Is knowledgeable on applicable Electrical Safety regulations, codes and requirements</li> </ul>
Non-qualified person (All Personnel)	Complies with the safety-related work practices and procedures within this Program
	<ul> <li>Is familiar with requirements outlined in the Electrical Safety program</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Informs their supervisor if they believe they are not fully qualified or trained for the task they have been given to perform</li> </ul>
	Stops any work deemed unsafe

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	<ul> <li>Takes appropriate action including communication to the appropriate management level when new or previously unknown hazards are identified</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Complies with established work methods and the use of protective equipment</li> </ul>
Contractor	<ul> <li>Ensures personnel are properly trained for the task they are performing and provide documentation of training if requested by Mosaic</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ensures personnel comply with the safety-related work practices and procedures within this Program.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ensures compliance with all applicable Federal (OSHA, MSHA, OHS, etc.) and Local regulations.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Provides all required PPE and electrical safety equipment for their personnel.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Advises Mosaic of the following:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Any unique hazards presented by the work</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Hazards identified during work that were not communicated by Mosaic</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The measures the contractor took to correct any violations reported by Mosaic and to prevent such violation from recurring in the future</li> </ul>
Attendant (Safety Observer)	<ul> <li>Monitors for unsafe conditions when work is being performed within Limited Approach Boundary</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Is aware of and understands equipment cutouts and electrical emergency procedures</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Provides warnings for unsafe conditions</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Keeps unqualified employees outside a work area where the unqualified employee might be exposed to electrical hazards</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Is qualified and trained in CPR</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Is a qualified person</li> </ul>

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Group / Role	Responsibilities
	<ul> <li>Shall have no other duties while acting in this capacity</li> </ul>
Training Department	<ul> <li>Provides, documents and maintains documentation of Electrical Safety training and retraining of Non-qualified personnel</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Coordinates with Electrical Supervision and Electrical Safety Program Administrator that Qualified Personnel are trained and maintains documentation of training</li> </ul>
