

## **ISNetworld Site Implementation 12/9/10**



- ISN is a contractor safety management/information database required to pre-qualify our contractors
- Implementation has been in progress throughout MNA during 2010
- Notification letters and phone calls to all FL/LA contractors/vendors in "waves"
  - Wave 1 March
  - Wave 2 April
  - Wave 3 Sept
  - Wave 4 (final) Oct
- User group meetings and conformance help desks in FL/LA conducted by ISN and Mosaic
- Conformance date is <u>December 17, 2010</u>
- Contractors will begin being evaluated for future work after conformance date – preference is to use "A" or "B" companies after that date
- Final notice letters and phone calls being made many



## **ISNetworld Site Implementation 12/9/10**



- Grade Criteria
  - A Exceptional, Recommended to Use
  - B Satisfactory, No Further Review Required
  - C Marginal, Site Mitigation Plan required, Department Manager Review/ Approval Required
  - F Unsatisfactory, Site Mitigation Plan required, Direct Mosaic or designee supervision is required at all times while on site, Facility General Manager approval required
- Next Steps
  - Communication to field site visits, memo distribution, ISN webinars (157 have participated to date)
  - Continue working with companies to improve grades
  - Process and forms for using C/F contractors, mitigation plan templates, waivers, etc.
  - Update Approved Vendor List with current ISN status.
     Vendor list should be used by all locations for contractor verifications when bidding work and issuing PR/PO's



## **ISNetworld Site Implementation 12/9/10**



- Contractor Variance Form
  - Recently revised to be used for all contractor variances
  - Required for any contractor not on approved vendor list, emergency contractors or those with C or F ratings in ISN
  - Form posted on purchasing/safety intranet sites or available from site buyer, safety or purchasing depts.
  - Completed forms forwarded to site buyers and site safety
- Site/Contractor Mitigation Form
  - Required for contractors with "C" or "F" ratings in ISN
  - Documents additional precautions contractor must take while on site, and how the company plans to improve their ISN rating
  - Form posted on purchasing/safety intranet sites or available from site buyer, safety or purchasing depts.
  - Completed forms forwarded to site buyers and site safety
- Variance Forms and Site Mitigation Plans must be approved and on file for all "C" or "F" contractors by 1/3/2011
