

Roles and Responsibilities EHSS-Phos Program – Hexavalent Chromium (CrVI), Appendix B

The following table outlines the responsibilities for specific groups / roles as required for *EHS-Phos Hexavalent Chromium (CrVI)* program:

Group / Role	Responsibilities
Site Leadership	 Ensure compliance with the Phosphates BU Hexavalent Chromium (CrVI) program requirements at their site.
Site Health and Safety Professional	 Provide subject matter expertise and oversight of the implementation of the Phosphates BU Hexavalent Chromium (CrVI) program at the facility level. Perform annual program audits.
Physician or other Licensed Health Care Professional (PLHCP)	 Perform or supervise all medical examinations and procedures required by law.
Supervisor	 Ensure this Program is followed by all employees and contractors. Ensure employees are trained prior to commencement of work activities involving Cr(VI).
All Employees	 Understand and comply with the safety-related work practices and procedures within this Program.
Contractors	 Understand and comply with the safety-related work practices and procedures within this Program. Ensure employees are trained prior to commencement of work activities involving Cr(VI). Provide all required personal protective equipment and safety equipment.
Contractor Safety Lead	 Ensure contractors understand and are aware of requirements of this Program.
