- Chevrolet C/K 2500 & HD Pickup, Flatbed, Utility, Van
- Chevrolet C/L 3500 & HD Pickup, Flatbed, Utility, Lube Body
- Chevrolet C/K 4500 & 5500 Flatbed, Utility, Lube Body
- Freightliner Medium Truck < 26,001 Lb. GVWR
- International Medium Truck < 26,001 Lb. GVWR
- Ford F-150 Pickup
- Ford F-250 SD Pickup, Flatbed, Utility
- Ford F-350 SD Flatbed, Utility
- Ford F-450 SD Pickup, Flatbed, Utility
- Ford F-550 SD Pickup, Flatbed, Utility

#### Vehicles requiring Commercial Driver's License (CDL)

(CDL requirements decision tree on next page)

- Freightliner Heavy Truck > 26,001 Lb. Digger, Bucket, Flatbed, Stinger, Maintenance, Dump, Semi.
- International Heavy Truck > 26,001 Lb. Digger, Bucket, Flatbed, Stinger, Maintenance, Dump, Semi.
- Mack Heavy Truck > 26,001 Lb. Digger, Bucket, Flatbed, Stinger, Maintenance, Dump, Semi.
- Sterling Heavy Truck > 26,001 Lb. Digger, Bucket, Flatbed, Stinger, Maintenance, Dump, Semi.
- Any vehicle carrying hazardous materials in placarded amounts  
Example: Diesel fuel greater than 119 gallons or 1,000 lb.

### COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE (CDL)

A CDL is required if you operate any of the following motor vehicles:

- A vehicle combination with a gross weight rating or gross vehicle weight of 26,001 pounds or more with a towed unit with a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of more than 10,000 pounds;
- A vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating or gross vehicle weight of 26,001 pounds or more;
- A vehicle designed to transport more than 15 persons, including the driver;
- A vehicle of any size used to transport hazardous materials and is required to be placarded.

When driving a vehicle not listed above, a valid Class E License is required.
